

Disneyland Paris – August 2011

A.R.T.S. will once again be travelling to Disneyland Paris, to perform a 20 minute show in the theme park. This will be our 3rd visit to Paris and it is always a fantastic trip popular with young and old alike. The trip is open to any ARTS student and their family. (All performers should be over the age of 5)

Due to the commitments of the ARTS Show, we now have very little time to secure our booking and pay our deposit! However, if there is sufficient interest in this trip – we should be able to complete all the necessary administration in time.

The details of the trip are as follows;

Included in your price are 2 nights bed and breakfast in Disneyland's Hotel Cheyenne for the nights of the 8th and 9th August plus 3 days of Disneyland park passes for the 8th, 9th and 10th August. All performers will take part in a 20 minute show performed on a Disneyland stage which really is a fantastic experience and opportunity.

Travel to and from Disney is not included and should be organized by yourselves. (We may be able to get a discounted price on the Eurostar for a group booking but we cannot guarantee that at this time.)

A deposit of £25.00 per person is payable by midday on **9th** December. Payments may be made in cash, by cheque or by credit card. At this time, we require only the names of the people in each room. Any rooms paid for after this date will cost an extra £15.00 per person.

The cost of the rooms are as follows;

£199.00 per person for 4 people staying in a room

£239.00 per person for 3 people in a room

£319.00 per person for 2 people in a room

NB. This cost will increase by £15.00 per person if your booking is made after midday on **9th December. (new extended time)**

Rehearsals will take place on Sunday mornings throughout the Summer term and costumes will cost approximately £30.00.

ARTS tracksuits will be required to wear in the theme park on the day of the Show.
